Three Truths about God ...

1) God is ______

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God is not some made-up philosophical construct or idea. Even though He is invisible, we can know He exists and is active through:

"For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse." – Romans 1:20

"He changes times and seasons; he removes kings and sets up kings; he gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding;" – Daniel 2:21



"And he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place, that they should seek God, and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him. Yet he is actually not far from each one of us," – Acts 17:26-27

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." – 2 Corinthians 5:17

"Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world." – **Hebrews 1:1-2**

"Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?" – John 14:9



What is the Trinity?

The Trinity is a theological term used to describe God's eternal existence as three distinct persons in one; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.





"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one." – **Deuteronomy 6:4**

The Trinity consists of three persons...

"Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal." – John 6:27

"To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ, who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen." – Romans 9:5

"...Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit... You have not lied to man but to God." - Acts 5:3-4



The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinguished from each other...

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"When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you," – John 17:1

"And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you." – John 16-17

"But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you." – John 14:26



God is mysterious and His nature infinitely higher than ours. Thankfully, His steadfastness is not dependent on our complete understanding. We can rely on the fact that God is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

"Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! 'For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?" – Romans 11:33-34
