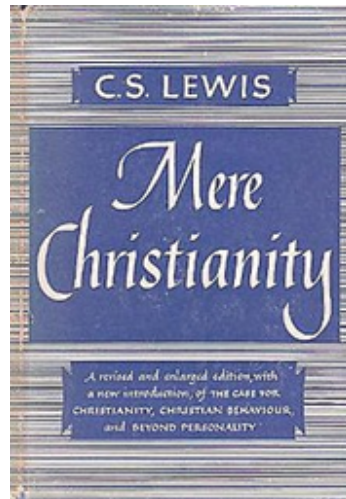

C.S. Lewis, in his book *Mere Christianity*, writes:

“I am trying here to prevent anyone from saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him: ‘I’m ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don’t accept his claim to be God.’ That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic—on a level with a man who says he is a poached egg—or else he would be the Devil of hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God, or else a madman or something worse. You can shut him up for fool, you can spit at him and kill him as a demon; or you can fall at his feet and call him Lord and God. But let us not come up with any patronizing nonsense about his being a great human teacher. He has not left that option open to us. He did not intend to.”

Jesus actually pointed to His miracles when asked for proof...

“And he answered them, ‘Go and tell John what you have seen and heard: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, the poor have good news preached to them.” - Luke 7:22

- **“the blind receive their sight...”** Matthew 9:27-31; Luke 18:35-43; Mark 8:22-26
- **“the lame walk...”** Matthew 9:2-7
- **“lepers are cleansed...”** Matthew 8:2-3; Luke 17:11-19
- **“the deaf hear...”** Mark 7:31-37
- **“the dead are raised up...”** Matthew 9:18-19, 23-25; Luke 7:11-15; John 11:1-44
- **“the poor have good news preached to them...”** Throughout the Gospels!

Not only did Jesus rise from the dead but He was also in complete control...

“For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life that I may take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This charge I have received from my Father.”

– John 10:17-18

On the third day He rose!

“But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise.” And they remembered his words,” – **Luke 24:1-8**

Jesus is Fully God and Fully Man...

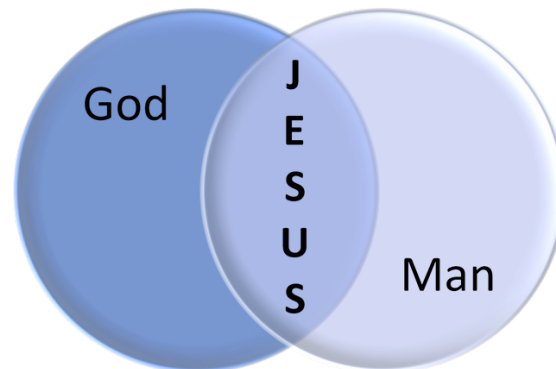
