

The Holy Spirit is a Person ...

What is the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit?

Before the Resurrection, the Spirit would come and go from individuals chosen by God, empowering them for great works of service for a period of time.

The Spirit entered...

"When he came to Lehi, the Philistines came shouting to meet him [Samson]. Then the Spirit of the Lord rushed upon him, and the ropes that were on his arms became as flax that has caught fire, and his bonds melted off his hands." – Judges 15:14

The Spirit departed...

"Now the Spirit of the Lord departed from Saul...." - 1 Samuel 16:14



Now, because we have been made righteous by the redemptive work of Jesus Christ completed on the cross, the Holy Spirit can reside in the human heart.

"Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you." – John 16:7

"But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit" – Titus 3:4-5





Jesus explains the new role the Holy Spirit now plays in lives of believers.

"And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you." – John 14:16-17

The Apostle Paul describes us as:

•

"Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.." – 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

When we accept Christ as our Savior, the Holy Spirit takes up residence in our heart, bringing with Him an entirely new life of love, relationship, and service to the Lord.



What does the Holy Spirit do?

The Holy Spirit is active in the lives of believers. The Bible calls the Holy Spirit our "Helper". He helps us in multiple ways:

"In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory." – Ephesians 1:13-14





•

"For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God." - Romans 8:14

"Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words."

- Romans 8:26

"But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you." – John 14:26





"For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills." – 1 Corinthians 12:8-11
