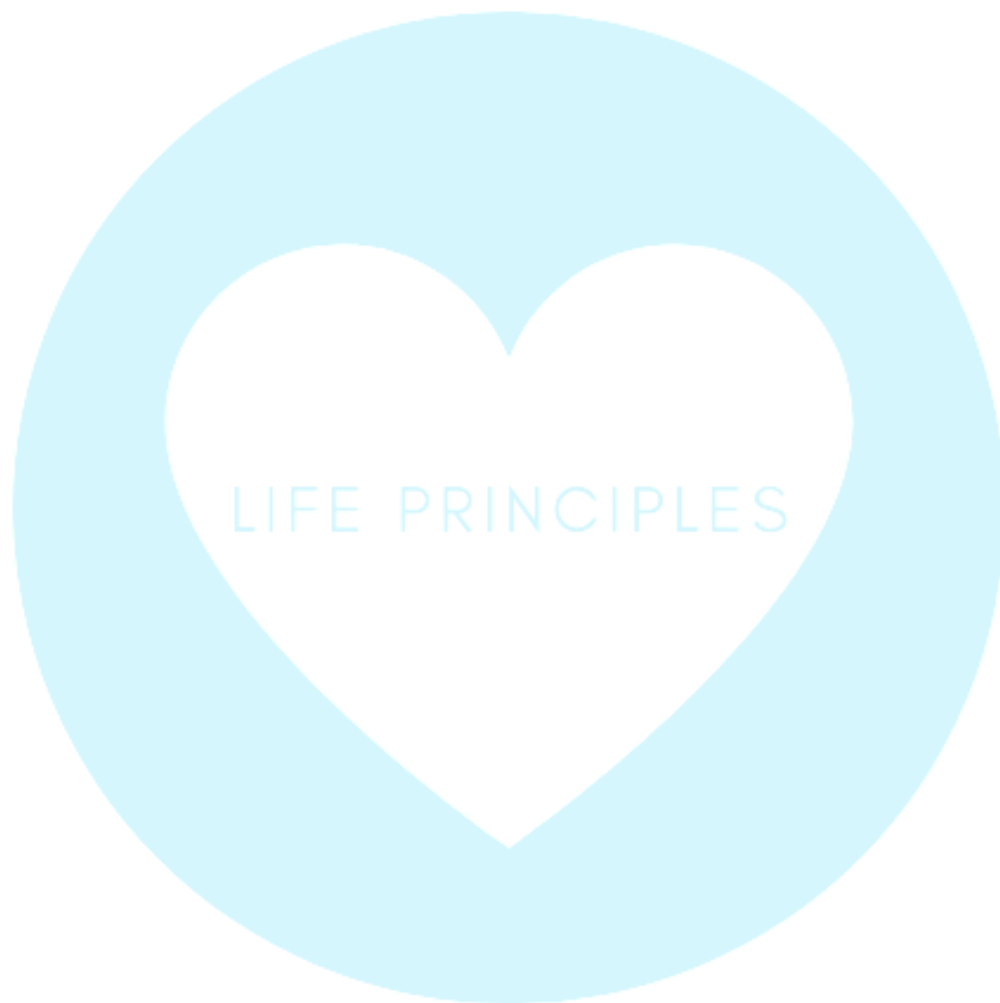

- i. **Jonah 1:1-2** Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, “Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and call out against it, for their evil has come up before me.”





- ii. How evil is Nineveh? See Nahum 3
- iii. **But JONAH,**
  - 1. **Jonah 1:3** But Jonah rose to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. He went down to Joppa and found a ship going to Tarshish. So he paid the fare and went down into it, to go with them to Tarshish, away from the presence of the Lord.
- iv. **But the Lord,**
  - 1. **Jonah 1:4** But the Lord hurled a great wind upon the sea, and there was a mighty tempest on the sea, so that the ship threatened to break up.
- v. Why is God so into Engaging our World?
- vi. **Jonah 4:11** And should not I pity Nineveh, that great city, in which there are more than 120,000 persons who do not know their right hand from their left, and also much cattle?"
- vii. God cares about people and cows
- viii. God is always pursuing people (Genesis 3)
- ix. Jesus is very into engaging our world (John 17)
